

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

My dear Parishioners,

For a while now, it has been my hope to move the speakers and the computer of our electronic bell system to the Church. Presently, the system is housed in the office building and the speakers are hung in the trees. The cute squirrels eat electric wire, did you know that? I didn't, but now I do. The reason for the move is not just because of the pesky squirrels. Having the system housed in the Sacristy and the speakers in the steeple will allow us to have greater ease in operating the bell system for special occasions. Presently, for instance, when the bells have to be rung during the Easter Vigil, our official bell ringers (Dot and Gordon) have to almost perform a miracle. Dot, in the Sacristy, using her cell phone, calls Gordon on his cell. Gordon, in the office building, gets called 10 seconds before the bells need to ring. Then Gordon pushes the button, all the while holding on with Dot so she can tell him when the Gloria is over, which is the cue to silence the bells. A couple times, they didn't remain on hold and when Dot tried to call Gordon again on the cell to tell him to turn off the bells, he couldn't hear the phone ring because the bells were so loud. So the bells kept ringing through the First Reading. The Liturgy wasn't ruined, but my blood pressure went up.

In addition to that, the steeple needs to be repainted. And it will be lighted with four spot lights. We had a practice light show one night with Bayou Electric, Gordon, John Ray and me and it was rather impressive..

Now the really amazing news is this: the generosity of our Knights of Columbus Council is making this happen for us with a very generous donation. And I didn't beg - they came to me asking if there was a project in which we could use assistance. And I hope you know me by now, I always have a project in mind, so I suggested this project and the Council agreed.

Thank a KC member when you see him. Men, consider becoming a KC. They do such good work for our parish. There is now a newly formed Ladies Auxilliary group for the wives of our Knights and that is wonderful.

I am so grateful to the Knights and Ladies Auxiliary, to all our parish organizations and ministries, to our staff and to all of you for making Queen of Angels a place where we can meet God and share life with one another.

Remember Sunday, 23 October at the 10:30 Mass, Bishop Deshotel will celebrate Mass for the first time here as our Bishop, followed by a jambalaya luncheon cooked by John Ray and crew and organized by the Altar Society and Seniors' Group.
