MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

My dear Parishioners,

One of the most inspiring professors I ever had in my seminary training was Abbot Patrick Regan. He taught at St. Joseph Seminary and was Abbot of St. Joseph Abbey in Covington. He died in February of this year. I attended his funeral at the Abbey and during the Funeral Mass, I must confess that my mind wandered. I thought how influential this man was in my formation as a priest. My love for the Liturgy and any knowledge I possess about it comes really from his teaching.

Every All Saints' Day at the Abbey, a lucernarium would appear in the Abbey Church. While the lucernarium service was a prayer service with the singing of the Psalms with candles lit, the actual candle holder is also called a lucernarium. Although the rule of the Church does not specify that there be a lucernarium on All Saints' Day, the good Abbot explained to me once why he did it. With the celebration of All Saints' Day until the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, Abbot Patrick said the Church enters into the darkest time of the year. The lucernarium reminds the Christian that even though there is darkness covering the earth, the Light of Grace stays alive.

This coming Wednesday is All Saints' Day. It is, of course, a Holy Day of Obligation. We won't have a lucernarium in the Church as the Abbot always did in his Abbey Church. Rather, why don't we become the light of grace to one another; why don't we become the beacon of radiant charity and generosity to those who are less fortunate; why don't we become the bright ray of hope to those in despair?

In the early Church, whenever a lucernarium was lit an ancient hymn was sung. Imagine the world singing the same song because you and I shine with the Light of Christ's love.

"O gracious light, pure brightness of the everlasting Father in heaven. O Jesus, Christ, holy and Blessed! Now as we come to the setting sun, and our eyes behold the vesper light, we sing thy praises O God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Thou art worthy at all times to be praised by happy voices!"
