CENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN AND BSA NEWS

As of this spring, our Parish pledged \$1,231,217.37 to the Centennial Campaign. To date, we have given \$706,910.15. Congratulations and thank you. Let us continue to be faithful to our pledges as we promised our good Bishop we would be. However, our goal for the BSA is \$47,392.00 in pledges, but we only pledged \$34,000.00. CENTENNIAL NEWS

Dedication of St. John the Evangelist - The impressive Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist in Lafayette is the result of the efforts of Fr. William Teurlings and the dedicated parishioners of St. John over one hundred years ago. The third church on this location, the cornerstone was laid in 1913 and took almost three years to complete. On June 27, 1916 the new church was consecrated by Bishop Laval, auxiliary Bishop of New Orleans. The Cathedral is Dutch Romanesque in style, reflecting the influence and vision of Fr. Teurlings, a native of the Netherlands, who came to southwest Louisiana as a young missionary priest in 1895.
