JANUARY MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

The annual meeting of Our Lady Queen of Angels Parish Council was held on January 9, 2018. Council members in attendance were: Msgr. Keith DeRouen, Bruce Gaudin, Deacon Bill Pollingue, Deacon Jerome Collins, Judge Jim Doherty, Charles Going, Elise Fontenot, Joe Hidalgo and Wayne Reed. The opening prayer was led by Msgr. DeRouen. Elise Hebert called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and approval of the Minutes from the previous Parish Council Meeting was given.

Bruce Gaudin asked for nominations of the three Council positions that needed to be filled. Charles Goings nominated Joe Hidalgo, seconded by Wayne Reed to serve another term as Vice President. Joe Hidalgo was approved with all in favor. Joe Hidalgo nominated Elise Fontenot, seconded by Charles Going to serve another term as Secretary. Elise Fontenot was approved with all in favor. Joe Hidalgo nominated Wayne Reed, seconded by Charles Going to serve as Chair of Organizations. Wayne Reed was approved with all in favor. They will serve until 2020.

Committee Reports were presented as follows:

a. The first report regarding Religious Education was given by Deacon Jerome Collins. He announced that we had a very successful CCD enrollment of 169 students with 49 making Confirmation and 23 making First Communion.

b. Deacon Bill Pollingue, Liturgy Chair, reported that baptism preparations are proceeding as normal with 3 this month and 3 more being prepared, however, there is a need for volunteers for the following ministries: Eucharistic Ministers at the 4:00 pm Saturday and 5:15 pm Sunday Masses, Lectors at the 5:15 pm Sunday Mass and more Altar Servers at all the Masses. It was also reported that the Lector schedule (made twice a year) is complete and will be emailed this week. Msgr. DeRouen asked for a periodic blanket email to all servers as a reminder to look at the schedule as everyone is very busy. Deacon Pollingue reported that the website is proceeding as normal.

CENTENNIAL NEWS

• Letter Sets Diocese of Lafayette into Motion - The very beginnings of the Diocese of Lafayette could be traced to a meeting of regional bishops held in July 1917. At the conclusion of that meeting, a letter was sent to the Apostolic Delegate of the Holy Father in the United States. The letter proclaimed that "there was unanimity among the Bishops in presenting the request for a new diocese to Your Excellency." The new diocese would consist of the western most part of the Archdiocese of New Orleans from the Atchafalaya River to the Sabine River. The total number of Catholics in the new diocese would be around 150,000 or 25% of the Catholics within the Archdiocese of New Orleans at the time.
