CENTENNIAL NEWS

• **Catholic Hospital in Lafayette Arrives by Accident** - In 1945, Bishop Jeanmard and Fr. Isenberg, rector of the Cathedral in Lafayette, were involved in a car accident near Baton Rouge and were treated at Our Lady of the Lake Hospital in Baton Rouge. They were both impressed with the care they received by the Franciscan Missionaries of Our Lady who ran the hospital. Isenberg immediately began working to bring these same religious sisters to the city of Lafayette. His dream was established on August, 1, 1949, when Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital opened with 50 beds just a few blocks away from the Cathedral of St. John in Lafayette.
