AUGUST MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

Our Lady Queen of Angels Parish Council meeting was held on **August 7, 2018**. Council members in attendance were: Bruce Gaudin, Jim Doherty, Charles Going, Keith Hebert, Richard Lucito, Elise Fontenot, Joe Hidalgo, Wayne Reed. The opening prayer was led by Bruce Gaudin. Elise Hebert called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and approval of the Minutes from the previous Parish Council Meeting was given.

Committee Reports were presented as follows:

a. **Religious Education**-Jerome Collins (no report)

b. The Liturgy report given by Deacon Bill Pollingue stated that Baptisms have slowed down. There have been more than 24 Baptisms since Easter. The report acknowledged a need for Altar Servers at the 4:00 p.m. and 5:15 p.m. Masses as well as a need for Eucharistic Ministers at all the masses, especially the 5:15 Mass, in order to have two full teams for each Mass. Since there are only 3 Lectors left due to illness and death, there continues to be a need for more Lectors at the 5:15 p.m. Sunday Mass. Adult Altar Servers are needed to help at Mass, especially daily Masses, as well as at the Nursing Home. We have picked up 1 new Adult Server, Ronald Dejean who serves at the 8:30 Sunday Mass. CENTENNIAL NEWS
• **50 Year old Parish** – In our Centennial Year, only one parish is celebrating its 50th Anniversary. In 1968, St. Pius X Church was designated a parish community. A small building on Kaliste Saloom Road had served as a mission church since 1959. In the first 50 years of the Diocese of Lafayette, 68 church parishes were established. After St. Pius in 1968, only 8 other churches would be established as a parish in the Diocese over the following 50 years. On October 5, 2017, the new St. Pius X Church was dedicated by Bishop Deshotel. The massive structure is a far cry from the original warehouse used in 1968.
• **Centennial Fest** – Honoring our Diocesan Centennial with our young people throughout the Diocese of Lafayette, we will have a **Youth Gathering at Parc International Downtown Lafayette on Saturday, October 20th from 3pm to 8pm** and will include Music, Guest Speakers, Mass, Food and closing with a Candlelight Eucharistic Adoration with Bishop Deshotel.
