**MINUTES OF OUR LADY QUEEN OF ANGELS CATHOLIC CHURCH
PARISH COUNCIL MEETING OF OCTOBER 30, 2018**

Attending were: Bruce Gaudin, Monsignor DeRouen, Jerome Collins, Bill Pollingue, Keith Hebert, Marie LeBlanc, Joe Hidalgo, and Jim Doherty.

The October meeting was called to order by President Bruce Gaudin and the opening prayer was led by Monsignor DeRouen. The July minutes were approved and all were in favor.

Committee reports were given as follows:

A. Religious Education – Deacon Jerome Collins – There are 146 students, 20 First Communion students and 33 Confirmation students.

B. Liturgy – Deacon Bill Pollingue – There are five applications currently being processed for Baptism. There continues to be a need for more Altar Servers at the 4:00 pm and 5:15 pm Masses. Lectors are still needed at the 5:15 pm Sunday Mass. There is also a need for more Adult Servers to help at Mass, especially daily Masses, as well as the Nursing Home. Ron Guillory has taken over scheduling of different ministries for service and is doing a great job. Regarding the Website, all is going well; donations are now coming through the website.

C. Organizations – Bruce Gaudin – In the last three months, monies were donated for cameras from the PoBoy Sale. The Priest Appreciation Banquet was attended by the Bishop and 10-12 priests from Our Lady Queen of Angels. 45 priests and 300 knights were present. \$7,500 was given to Bishop Deshotel for vocations. Tony Chachere's donated the food.
