

MINUTES OF OUR LADY QUEEN OF ANGELS CATHOLIC CHURCH
PARISH COUNCIL MEETING OF OCTOBER 30, 2018 - CONTINUED

E. Seniors and Handicapped – Marie LeBlanc - The Senior Angels Group held its first meeting of the 2018-2019 year on October 10, 2018. The proposed annual calendar was presented for discussion and approval. A major agenda topic was the scheduling of the annual Card Party. The potential date, pending approval of Monsignor DeRouen, will be May 1, with all registrations to be complete by April 17. The Angels have also scheduled their participation in Family Fun Day on April 14 and will donate individually wrapped desserts again this year. Our Angels will once again host the popular May Rosary/Coffee Reception, with a rosary led by Monsignor DeRouen. The date is tentatively scheduled for May 8, pending Monsignor's approval. We are presently discussing an Advent Day of Recollection during the Advent Season. As it has been for the past 2 years, this is a day of recollection led by Monsignor and inclusive of spiritual meditations to assist all attendees in maintaining the true meaning of Advent. The decision to schedule or not schedule will be made at our November meeting. This past summer, the Senior Angels used \$711.55 from the profits of our Card Party to pay for Fiber Services fees to clean and provide stain-resisting treatment for the cushions on the white Chivari chairs which are used for the card party and other events. Additional monies from those same profits will be used to purchase more orange tablecloths to be used at the Thanksgiving Dinner to be held on Sunday before Thanksgiving.

F. Nominating Committee – The next item on the agenda was in reference to the appointment of a Nominating Committee. Terms that will expire on December 31, 2018 are those of Joe Hidalgo and Charlie Dore. President Gaudin stated that we last had an election in November. If there are more than two nominees, we will need a nominating committee. The office will do the necessary paperwork.

G. Old Business – It was stated that trees have been cut, potholes have been fixed, cameras have been installed, and the air conditioning unit was changed by Wayne Bergeron.

H. New Business – There was no new business.

I. Date of Next Meeting – The date of the next meeting will be January 29, 2019.

J. Closing Prayer – Closing prayer was led by Monsignor DeRouen.
