**MINUTES OF OUR LADY QUEEN OF ANGELS CATHOLIC CHURCH
PARISH COUNCIL MEETING ON APRIL 2, 2019**

The opening prayer was led by Monsignor DeRouen followed by roll call by Marie LeBlanc. The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. There was a motion to approve the minutes by Joe Hidalgo and seconded by Richard Lucito. It was approved with all in favor.

Committee Reports:

A. Religious Education – Jerome Collins (submitted report)

Reported that our CCD year will end on April 8th. First Communion Retreat will be held April 13 with First Confessions on April 6 and First Holy Communion at 1:00 p.m. on April 28. The Confirmation Retreat was held on March 15 through March 17 given by the “Utopia” retreat team. The Confirmation Mass will take place on May 5 at 1:00 p.m.

B. Liturgy – Bill Pollingue (no report)

Remarks by Monsignor DeRouen— presently working to get everything in order for the liturgical schedule. We will not be losing any altar servers, but will need to do an appeal after school starts to get more servers.

C. Finance – Charles Going (no report)

Remarks by Judge Doherty: We are within budget; offertory has increased as compared to last year. We will essentially break even with rebates from Centennial Campaign and Bishops Services Appeal. A meeting was held on March 27.

D. Evangelization – Judi Lucito (no report)

Remarks by Richard Lucito: Program has not lost anyone; attended event in Lafayette where every parish in the diocese announces their catechumens. We have one catechumen, 2 Protestants, and 2 Catholics who need confirmation. Richard asks all to reach out to everyone. This group meets every week, beginning in September. There are now 60 members in this group.
