MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

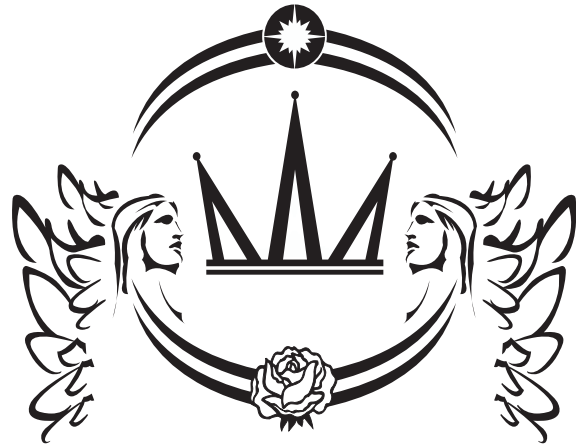
My Dear Parishioners:
