**MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR**

My Dear Parishioners:

I wonder how many of us made a gumbo this past week. I made containers for my freezer last Friday, anticipating this week's cool fronts. This letter will be filled with some information. So, here we go....This week, I will be making my retreat with some of my brother priests. Please pray for us. After the retreat, I'll be attending a conference out of state for a few days with an organization that works to secure Christian/Catholic presence in the Holy Land.

The work in the Church is done for now, but I am hoping to get a grant from the Stuller Foundation. If we are awarded that grant and the amount I requested, we will finish the interior painting of the Church and sacristy. We will also be installing new lighting panels that are located where the air conditioners are. These panels will last 50,000 hours, which we guess would be 50 years given the hours per week we have them on. I was able to get donations from Mr. Bobby Dupre and the KCs to pay for the new lighting. That will happen in the next few weeks. Please do say a prayer that we are awarded the grant money from the Stuller Foundation. That would be such a blessing and the interior of the Church would be completely refurbished.

We are behind in putting together the end of the year financial report. (The end of the fiscal year was 30 June). The Diocesan Fiscal Office has had some personnel changes and, as a result, delays. But, I do want to thank you again and again for this past year's response to increasing the offertory. The appeal was made a year ago and your generosity is ongoing and heartwarming.

Don't forget to pray for me this coming week while I am on retreat and while I am at the conference. Please know that I will be praying for you.
