Below is a list that came from a retreat experience of a friend of mine that I modified for myself. Perhaps you may be inspired by some of these statements in order to take better care of our fragile lives, bombarded by so many negative and scary realities today. The title, "With God, I Am Enough" used to be my mantra that I would repeat when I swam laps for exercise. Notice, too, the supposedly unlucky number of 13. For the person of faith, even the number 13 can be a winner.
