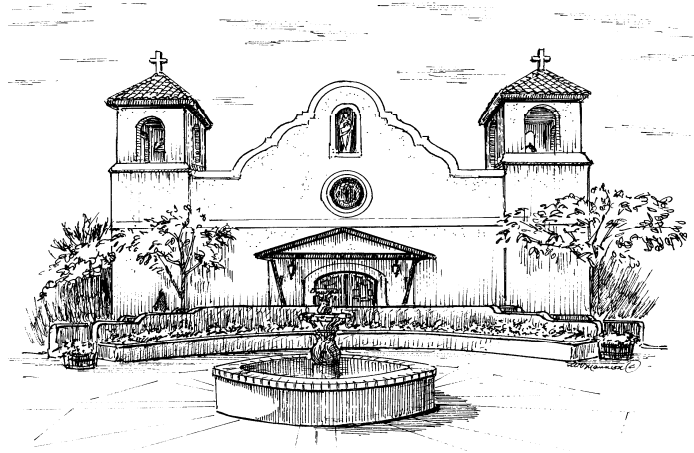

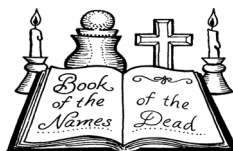
As Pilgrims wear a cross, or some other distinctive badge of their pilgrimage, so the Church gives us the cross of ashes on Ash Wednesday.
