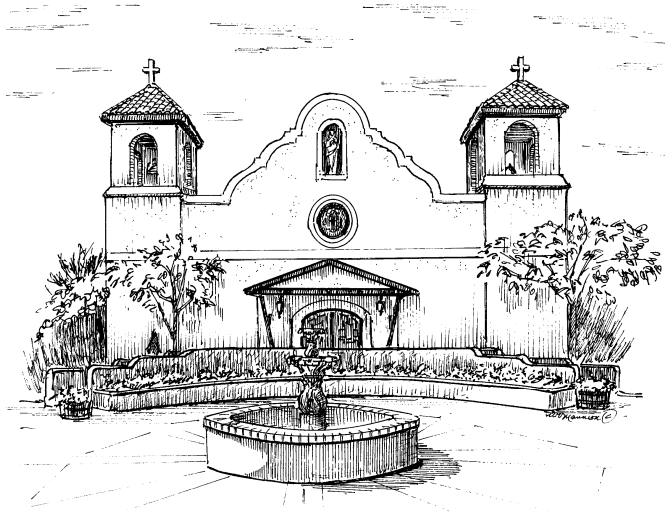

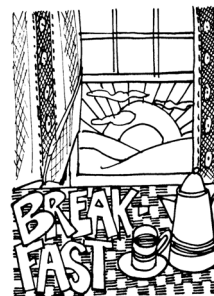
"She's a girl in my parish youth group," Matt explained to Miss Collins.
