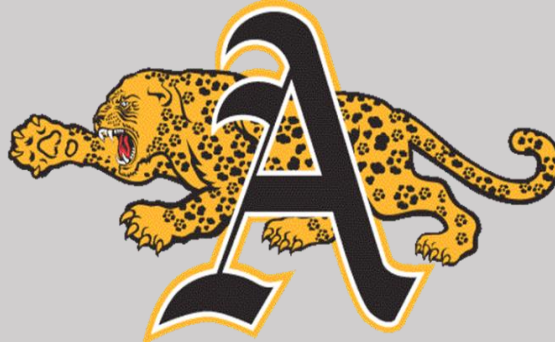
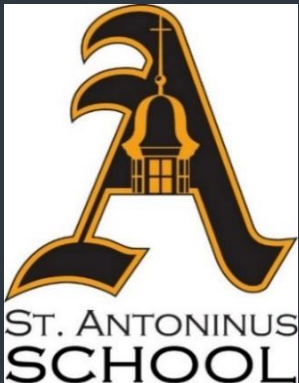

Dear Parents,

We are completing the end of the First Trimester this week! We will celebrate this fact by having a special "Survivor Day" on Friday (11/13). Students may come out of uniform and our PTO will provide a slice of pizza and chips for lunch. I'm very proud of each of our students, teachers, and staff for not only surviving but thriving during these last twelve weeks!

By now all parishioners should have received an Annual Fund brochure in the mail. The purpose for this fund is to provide much needed technology for our students. We had hoped to receive CARES monies to use but were denied these funds because we aren't a school with high poverty. That's a good classification, yes, but we are technology poorer in that we need more devices and upgrades. Each of our aging classroom smartboards is \$4,000.00 and student computers are \$500.00 each with all that they require. We have only one grade (Fifth) with new computers and many of our classrooms need replacement smartboards. Please help us if you can do so. From time to time, we will list donor families and later we will publish end of the school year results of this general ask. To date we have donations totaling \$4,945.00 with hopefully much more to come. Thank you!

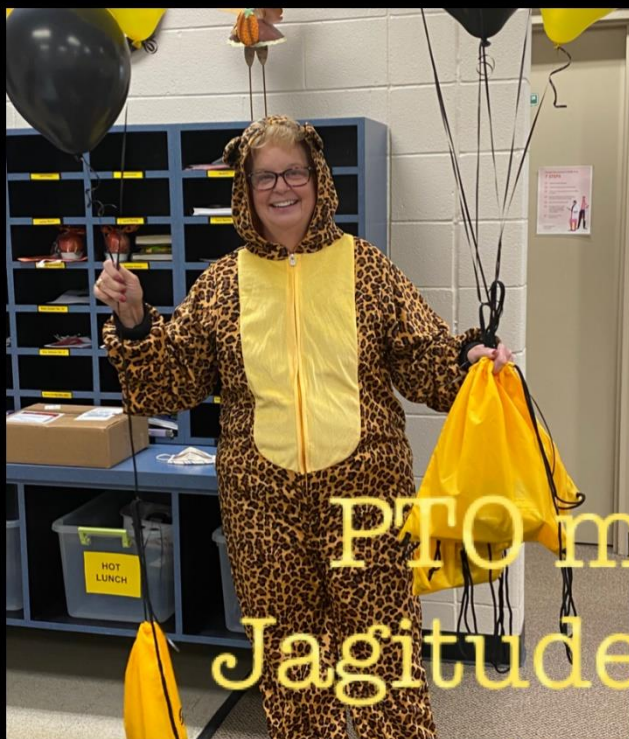
