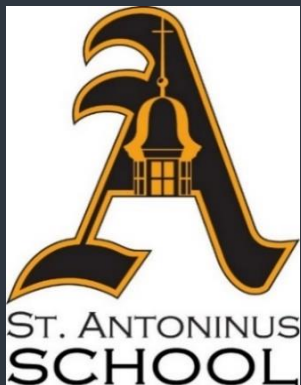

## **THE ROSEMOND REPORT**

Dear Parents,

Tomorrow we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. There will be two separate masses just for our students. Grades 1-4 will attend mass at 10:45, and Grades 5-8 will attend mass at 1:00. You'll recall that this feast celebrates the fact that Mary was born without original sin, making her the perfect one to be the Mother of Jesus. Hail, Mary!

I am aware that some neighboring schools have gone to virtual learning until Christmas. I will continue to monitor our school's absences and illnesses, but at this time we will remain open. I, myself, am positive for the virus (from helping my mother, who later was found to be positive for Covid) and completing a 14-day quarantine.
