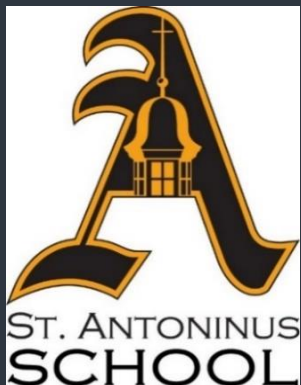

### **FORGOTTEN ITEMS**

- School may not have parent visitors during the school day when children are present. If your child forgot their lunch, eyeglasses or medication a parent can drop off that item on the table in the main lobby of school (a mask must be worn before you enter the building). ### **TARDIES & EARLY DISMISSALS**

**Tardies-** A parent must walk their child to the front door and ring the doorbell. The child will enter the school by themselves and will get his/her temperature taken. If the child has a normal temperature, the parent will be given the go ahead to leave.

**Early Dismissals-**all parents must email their child's teacher and the school office giving them the day and time of the early dismissal needed. We will make sure your child is ready for their scheduled pick up time. Parents will ring the doorbell and we will send your child out to you.
