- **ST. A POLICY FOR APPOINTMENTS, SCHEUDLED EVENTS, & VACATION REMINDER**

Whenever possible, medical and dental appointments should be scheduled outside of school hours. Family vacations, during the school year, are discouraged for educational reasons. Assignments may not be given in advance. The responsibility lies with the student to get missed assignments. Any work given out prior to an arranged vacation is due upon return. Any work not given in advance after an arranged absence is given one day, per day absent, to complete missed work. While prearranged absences are generally discouraged, St. Antoninus School recognizes that certain occupations and events scheduled out of parents' control prohibit all vacations from occurring during the normal school vacation times.
