THE ROSEMOND REPORT

Dear Parents,

A couple of months ago you were asked to give input through an online parent survey about our school. After receiving the compiled results, I first shared the info with our faculty. I met this past week and discussed subsequent plans at our monthly Education Commission meeting. They are now informed about our next steps, and now I'm writing to give you the same information.

First, please take a look at the attached data in PDF form. There's the Parent Survey results as well as the Student Survey results. As you might expect, most of the results were very positive. Two areas stood out to me as ones to target for improvement. Revamping discipline and bullying prevention seemed to come to the forefront as the main two focus areas. Both discipline and bullying are hot topics everywhere but certainly worth our time to target for improvement. I have already revamped our discipline code for next year, with faculty input. I am also scheduling a Bullying Prevention Program, through the Council on Child Abuse, for next fall. COCA has programs appropriate for students and staff, and it has parent components as well.

Thanks once again to all who took time to share their opinions. Your input helps us to better focus our efforts. I will continue to ask for your valuable insights.
