(ex. They had a certain Jagitude about them.)



This past week on May 5<sup>th</sup>, the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade Accelerated Math students participated in Maths Day. This is a worldwide competition hosted by Mathletics. During this event, students participated in 20 one minute games where they had to complete different math challenges ranging from easy to more difficult math problems. The 2021 levels are:

- Passer(8U)à birth year 2013 & 2014 (any 1<sup>st</sup> grader born in 2015 will play this level)
- Wings(10U)à birth year 2012 & 2011
- Striker(12U) à birth year 2010 & 2009
- Kicker(14U) à birth year 2008 & 2007

Circumstances might occur in which a player(s) may be 'moved up' but it is need based (too many or not enough at a level) – please do not request a player to be moved. Please spread the word that sign-ups are open to friends, family & neighbors (especially to newer families who may not be on the Athletic Club e-mail distribution list)!
