(ex. They had a certain Jagitude about them.)

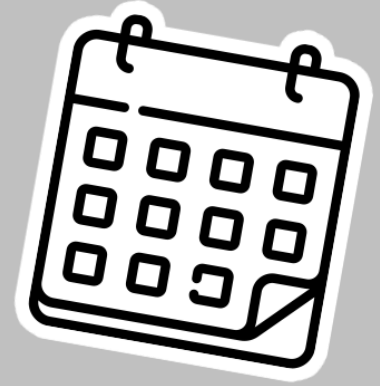

- **ACEO INFORMATION**

Here are high level details of what ACEO is about. Advocates for Catholic Education and Organizations (ACEO) is a non-profit organization established to provide scholarship/grant opportunities for individuals participating in the organization. ACEO assists with parochial and college education as well as family friendly, non-profit organizations. The program is based on Christian Values and promotes team work and positive attitudes. Scholarships are raised each time you work an event with ACEO at the Ballpark. The scholarship earned is sent to the non-profit organization of your choice once a quarter. You must be at least 16 years of age to work the Reds games. You will be required to complete online training and forms and attend a one-hour session at the ballpark. You must be able to work in a concession stand (work on a register, pour beer, grill, setup, cleanup, etc). You will be at the ball park for approximately 7-8 hours and you will be on your feet this entire time without breaks.
