



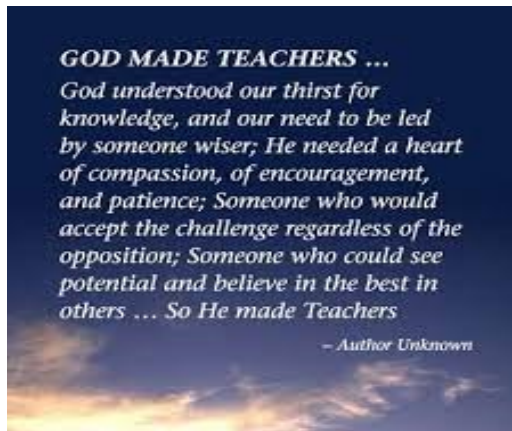

- *Passer(8U) à birth year 2013 & 2014 (any 1<sup>st</sup> grader born in 2015 will play this level)*
- *Wings(10U) à birth year 2012 & 2011*
- *Striker(12U) à birth year 2010 & 2009*
- *Kicker(14U) à birth year 2008 & 2007*

Circumstances might occur in which a player(s) may be 'moved up' but it is need based (too many or not enough at a level) – please do not request a player to be moved. Please spread the word that sign-ups are open to friends, family & neighbors (especially to newer families who may not be on the Athletic Club e-mail distribution list)! Sign-ups must occur through online registration – manual player registration will only occur in the rarest of cases. Sign-ups will be open through the month of May with the final date to sign-up Monday May 31<sup>st</sup>.
