

Welcome to the beginning of a new school year. In order to guarantee your child and all the students in the classroom the excellent educational climate they deserve, I am utilizing the following classroom plan.

CLASSROOM POLICY:

- Demonstrate responsible and respectable behavior to others in the classroom and at other places.
- Students are expected to follow all rules/code of conduct explained in the St. Antoninus Handbook (please refer to the school handbook for questions on rules/code of conduct).
- Be positive in all that you do.

If a student chooses to NOT follow this policy, the following consequences will occur:

- ⊗ A verbal warning will be given. If a second warning is given, students will be issued demerit points according to the school code of conduct plan found in the St. Antoninus Handbook.
- ⊗ Any more warnings may result in more demerits, notification to parents, and/or being sent to the principal.

HOMEWORK POLICY:

- ✓ Be prepared for class (computer, books, paper, pencils, pens, and assignments) and ready to begin on time.
- ✓ All assignments are to be given the student's best effort.
- ✓ Assignments are due on the day assigned. Assignments are considered late if not complete and, in the classroom, when requested. Be aware that not all assignments will count as a grade but do serve a purpose for completion and understanding of concepts and can still be counted as late.
- ✓ Students are given three days to turn in missing assignments. He/She will incur a ten-point deduction on the grade for each day it is late. Assignments will not be accepted for a grade after the third day and will be recorded as a zero.
- ✓ Being absent does not count as a missing assignment for that day and students will have as many days as they were absent to make up any missing work. It is the student's responsibility to check with me for the work that was due or needing to be made up. Exceptions will be made due to Covid-19 quarantine absence.
- ✓ Any student with three late, incomplete, or missing assignments will be issued in conduct points. Receiving more than three late, incomplete, or missing assignments will result in an "X" on the trimester report card for being unprepared for class.

GRADING CRITERIA:

Math:

Tests--50 % Assignments--25 %
Quizzes—25%

Religion:

Classwork--50 %
Tests--50 %

All tests and most quizzes will be announced at least three days in advance. All student work and handouts should be kept in a binder just for math until after report cards go home which we will then clean out the binder at school.

It is in your child's best interest that we work together regarding his/her education and development. I will try to keep you informed about your child's progress, academically and/or behaviorally, in my class using the online grading program and other means. If there is a legitimate reason why your child is unable to finish their homework, please send a note on the day the assignment is due stating the reason and I will take into consideration to count it as late or not. Exceptions will be made due to Covid-19 quarantine absence.
