(ex. They had a certain Jagitude about them.)

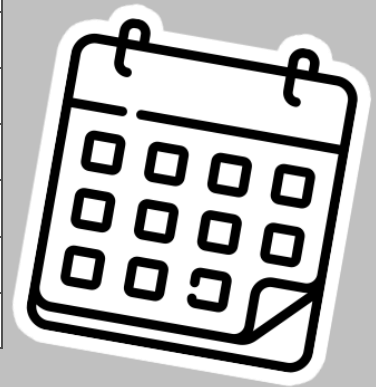

◆ **BUS SERVICE**

Bus service will begin on Friday, August 20th for both Oak Hills & Cincinnati Public. Please arrange transportation for your child on Thursday, August 19th.

◆ **BACK TO SCHOOL PAPERWORK**

On the first day of school, your child will receive “back to school “ paperwork. Please complete all paperwork (front & back) and return to school no later than Friday, August 27th.

◆ **FORGOTTEN ITEMS**

If your child forgot their lunch, water bottle, eyeglasses or medication, a parent can drop off the item on the table in the main lobby of school . You may **NOT** drop off forgotten books, homework or projects.

◆ **TARDIES & EARLY DISMISSALS**

If possible please do not schedule appointments during the school day. If your child is tardy or needs to leave school early, please email or call Mrs. Steinbeck. Early Dismissals-all parents must email their child’s teacher and the school office giving them the day and time of the early dismissal needed. We will make sure your child is ready for their scheduled pick up time. Parents will ring the doorbell and we will send your child out to you.
