Dear Parents,

This week we will have an opportunity to meet with many here at school. On both Wednesday and Thursday evenings, we will have **Meet the Teacher** nights. The two evenings will both start right at 7:00, in school, and there will be two classroom sessions. Wednesday evening (9/1) is for Grades 1-4 and Thursday evening (9/2) is for Grades 5-8. Our younger grade teachers will meet you in their homerooms and older grade teachers will meet with parents by grade levels, so that you may hear from all. We won't meet ahead of time this year, but rather go straight to the true purpose of the evening. I will open our main front doors of the school, by 6:45, both evenings, so that you may all park, enter, and be in the classrooms on time. I look forward to seeing you!

At present, we do have a possible case of COVID pending. The child is at home, with some symptoms and is being tested. At some point this is/was bound to happen. Many of our surrounding Catholic Schools do have positive cases at this time. We hate to have to quarantine anyone, but we will use contact tracing and need to do so, if anyone in fact tests positive. Please keep your child/children at home if they show any symptoms. Do strongly consider having your child wear a mask, so that they may remain in school, even if exposed, but are symptom free. Classroom temperatures have moderated quite a bit and will do so even more during this week.

I'm sure you are all aware of the devastating hurricane (Ida) that hit the southern states yesterday. We will take up a monetary collection to send to them via Catholic Relief Services after mass this Friday. Let's keep them also in our daily prayers.
