(ex. They had a certain Jagitude about them.)



◆ **PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

All of our Language Arts and Reading Teachers (K-8) took part in, *Launching the Writer's Workshop*, virtually, over the summer months, which gave our teachers a framework of lessons that helped to launch writing in their classrooms. They will also have a modeling of best practices by a visiting literacy consultant in mid-October. There will be daytime instruction as well as mini-lessons conducted, within some of our classes, directly with our students, to demonstrate different methods of writing instruction. You may have a budding author (or two or three) in your midst soon! We also had training through SOITA before school started for those who wished to learn 3-D printing (14 teachers took part), How to Create Instructional Videos (15 teachers took part), Using Virtual Headsets (5 Teachers took part) and Teaching with Dot, Dash, and Que (2 Teachers took part). All sessions were in August before school began and everyone did at least one class, some did all of the offered sessions. We are all lifelong learners! Even teachers are never finished needing instruction and improving their craft. Please applaud their efforts, and those of your children too, whenever you see any of these newly acquired skills in use!
