Parent Guidelines

We believe that parents are the foundation of their child's faith formation. Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) co-foundress, Sofia Cavaletti, responded to the child's cry, "Help me find God by myself." ___ I will attend the Parent Information Night (date and time to be announced). If I am unable to attend, I will arrange a meeting with a catechist.

___ Understanding that attendance and punctuality are very important to the work flow of the atrium, I will ensure my child(ren) are on time to and in attendance for their weekly sessions.
