

# CADETS OF ST. GEORGE PLAN STREET PARADE

## Will March With Other Societies in Anniversary Pageant.

The fifteenth anniversary of the organization of the Cadets of St. George, Bohemian Catholic military society attached to St. Adalbert Bohemian Catholic church, 2347 E. 83d-st S. E., is to be celebrated June 13.

The event, which will include a street parade made up of all military societies of St. Adalbert's and of the Cadets of St. Stanislaw, attached to St. Prokop Bohemian Catholic church, W. 41st-st and Trent-av S.
