

# Diocese Names First Negro Copastor of Parish

The Rev. Gene R. Wilson next Wednesday will become the first Negro copastor of a parish in the Cleveland Catholic Diocese.

Nine years ago, when he was ordained as a priest of the Society of the Precious Blood, he was the first Cleveland Negro to become a Roman Catholic priest.

Father Wilson's new assignment to St. Adalbert parish at 2345 E. 83d Street was one of about 60 announced today by the chancellor's office.

FOUR NEW pastors were listed:

The Rev. Edward J. Murphy, pastor of Epiphany parish, will become pastor of St. James Church, Lakewood. He will succeed Msgr. Daniel T. Gallagher who retired in April after serving as pastor since 1942.

Msgr. Richard E. McHale, former superintendent of schools, will be pastor of Epiphany parish and episcopal vicar for education.

The Rev. Casimir R. Pilatowski, pastor of Assumption parish in Grafton, O., was named pastor of St. Casimir parish, E. 82d Street and Sowinski Avenue N.E.

The Rev. Stanley A. Cymanski, administrator of St. Casimir, will become pastor of Assumption in Grafton.

IN ANOTHER appointment, the Rev. John F. Neary will become administrator of St. Dominic parish in Shaker Heights while the

Rev. Arthur L. Gallagher remains as pastor.

Father Neary, now assistant pastor at Assumption parish, served as assistant pastor of St. Dominic from 1957 to 1963.

At St. Adalbert, with about 500 parishioners, Father Wilson, 40, will serve as co-pastor with the Rev. Fredrick J. O'Brien, 52. Adalbert's pastor since 1965.

Father Wilson has been librarian at Brunnerdale Seminary in Canton.

ANOTHER ORDER priest at St. Adalbert, the Rev. Ralph Schneider, C.P.P.S., was transferred to Our Lady of Good Counsel parish. He replaces the Rev. Clement Alt, C.P.P.S. who will become a pastor in Wapakoneta, O., in another diocese.

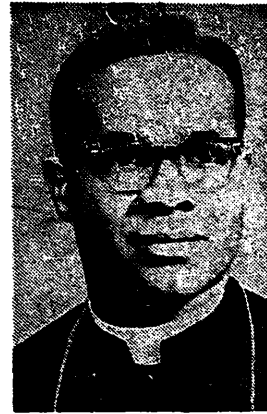

## Persecution Petition Is Given U.N.

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (AP) — A petition signed by 54 Soviet citizens alleging political persecution has reached U.N. headquarters by way of London apparently after encountering a Soviet-manned U.N. roadblock in Moscow.

A U.N. spokesman said yesterday the petition was forwarded from London by Martin Ennals, secretary-general of Amnesty International, a refugee aid organization.

The petition directed to the U.N. Human Rights Commission, surfaced in Moscow last May 22. It protested the arrest of two Soviet dissenters, former Maj. Gen. Pyotr Grigoryenko and Ilya G abai, a poet and teacher.

THE SIGNERS protested "unceasing political persecutions in the Soviet Union, perceiving in them a return" to Stalinism.

The U.N. spokesman, in reply to questions, said he was inquiring into a published report that the U.N. information center in Moscow had refused to accept the petition for forwarding.

## Workers at B-W Reject Union

Nonacademic employees at Baldwin-Wallace College yesterday voted by a two-to-one margin not to affiliate with Local 78 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees.

Of the 167 employees, 149 voted in the election. Only 46 voted to join the union. The election agreement bars affiliation with any other union or bargaining agent for the next year.

Involved in the election were building and grounds workers, food service employees, custodians, truck drivers and secretaries.

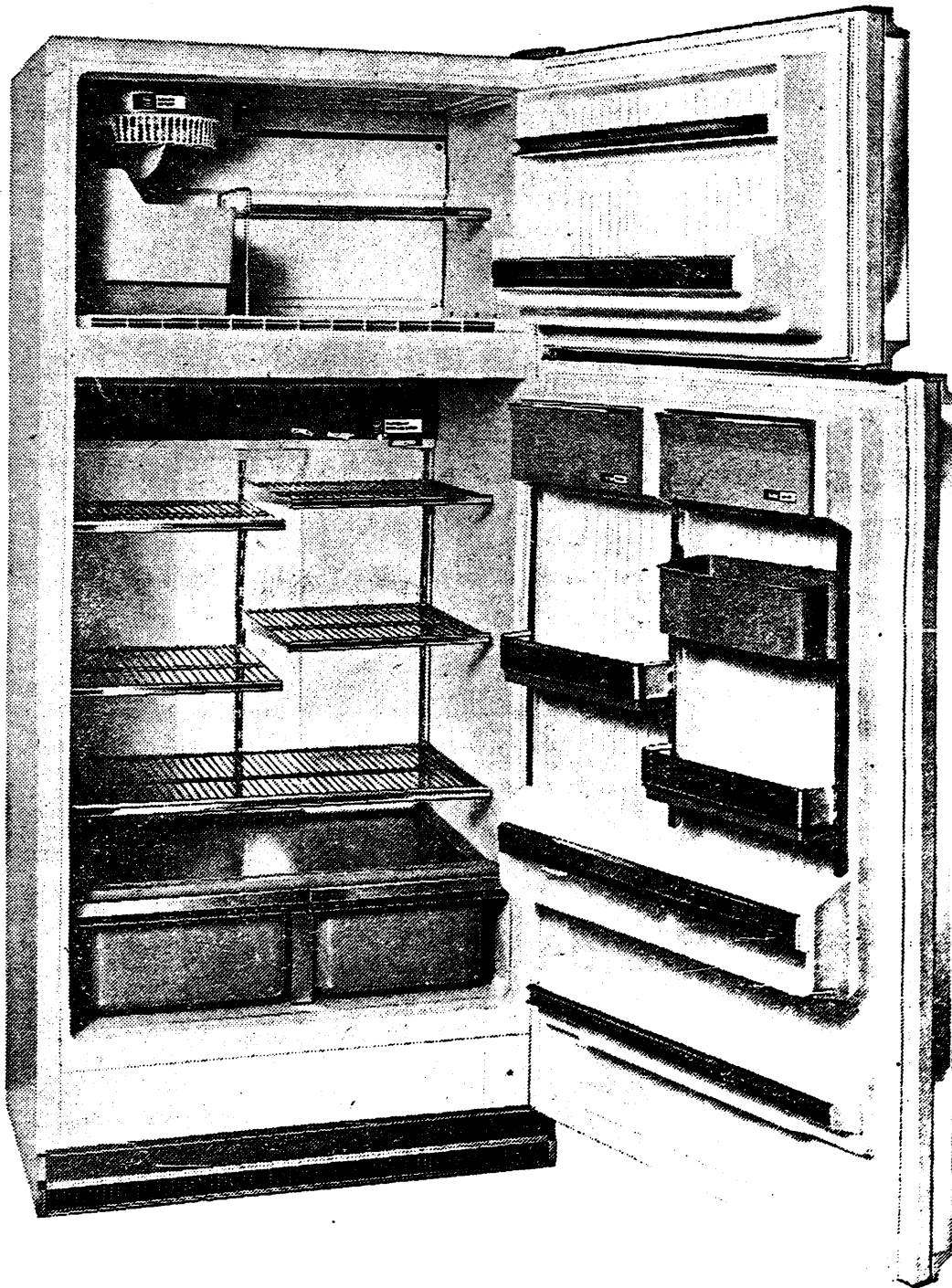
