

Archbishop Prods Labor, Management

ARCHBISHOP EDWARD F. HOBAN of the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland in his annual Labor Day message calls upon individual Americans and labor and management organizations "to consider most seriously their obligation for the cause of America."

The archbishop's message will appear in the Labor Day publication of the Association of Catholic Trade Unionists which will be distributed Monday at the annual Labor Day mass in St. John Cathedral at 12:15 p.m. Msgr. Francis A. Cacciari, pastor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church, Notre Dame Avenue and Mount Carmel Road S. E., will officiate at the mass.

Outdoor Mass To Be Held
In another Labor Day religious observance, Auxiliary Bishop John F. Whealon will officiate at 11 a.m. at an outdoor mass on the grounds of St. Vincent de Paul Church, Vincent, Lorain County. The church is located on State Route 254, west of Route 57.

Msgr. Francis W. Carney, director of the Institute of Social Education of St. John College will preach. This is being sponsored by the Lorain Deaneys Priests Liturgical Committee, headed by the Rev. Joseph Lembach, pastor of St. Joseph Church, Amherst.

The archbishop in his message refers to the recent encyclical of Pope John XXIII, entitled Mater et Magistra, and expressed the prayerful hope that "labor and management, as they pause on this Labor Day to reappraise their past performance and make their plans for the coming year, will subordinate all other considerations to the common good of all Americans and of all mankind." And that they will do this, he writes, in the words of Pope John, "to the praise of God and the service of justice."

Catholics Set Up Classes for Public School Pupils

Officials of the Diocesan Catholic School Board, in addition to planning for the opening of school next week, are also giving thought to the religious instructions of Catholic children who will attend public schools.

More than 43,000 children of elementary and high school levels were enrolled in the classes last year. These classes were taught by approximately 1,000 teachers including pastors, nuns and lay people.

This instruction program is conducted by the diocesan office of the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine. Msgr. Richard E. McHale is director. He is assistant director of schools.

Religious instructions are given outside of public school hours. Evening classes in the church are held for high school pupils and Sunday "after mass" classes for elementary grades.
