

WITH POMP AND CEREMONY

Cornerstone of New Church of St. Ladislav Was Laid Yesterday.

With pomp and ceremony the cornerstone of the new Church of St. Ladislav on Conwin avenue was laid yesterday afternoon by Msgr. G. F. Houck, Assisting the chancellor were a large number of the Slavish and Bohemian priests of the city.

The parade, which was formed to escort the chancellor to the church, included besides a number of companies of the uniformed Knights of St. John and Knights of Malta and the Catholic cadets a dozen or more marching clubs connected with various churches about the city. There were in all over 1,000 men in line, including the National Slavish band, the band of the Knights of Malta.

A great crowd assembled at the church to witness the ceremonies. The regular Catholic ritualistic service was said by the chancellor and the assisting clergymen, after which the stone was set in place. Assisting the chancellor were: Rev. John Svozil, pastor of the church; Rev. Stephen Purdek, pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes; Rev. Wenceslas J. Horak, pastor of St. Martin's; Rev. Ladislav of St. Mary's of the Nativity; Rev. Udalrich Zlamal of St. Wendelin's; Rev. Ladislav Kloucek of St. Adalbert's, and Rev. Joseph M. Koudelka of St. Michael's.
