Basic Eligibility Requirements to apply for the First time

1. All documents proving entry into the U.S. before the age of 16
2. All documents proving continuous residence in the U.S. from June 15, 2007 to present
3. All documents pertaining to proof of U.S. presence on June 15, 2012
4. All documents proving your identity (Photo ID, Passport, and Birth Certificate)
5. Court records of criminal or juvenile records (If applicable)
6. All documents pertaining to lawful entry into the U.S. (If applicable)

Who Can Renew

You may request a renewal if you met the [initial DACA guidelines](#) and you:

- Did not depart the United States on or after Aug. 15, 2012, without advance parole;
- Have continuously resided in the United States since you submitted your most recent DACA request that was approved; and
- Have not been convicted of a felony, a significant misdemeanor, or three or more misdemeanors, and do not otherwise pose a threat to national security or public safety.

When to Renew

You should submit your renewal request about 120 days (4 months) before your current period of deferred action will expire. If you submit your request more than 150 days (5 months) before your current period expires, USCIS may reject it and return it to you with instructions to resubmit it closer to the expiration date.
