Please be aware that due to Covid -19, new protocols have been implemented to protect the health of all campers and staff. This includes yet not limited to:

- Each camp will have limited attendance.
- Each camper will need to present a **lab confirmed negative PRC Covid-19 test**, within five (5) days prior to camp start date, upon their arrival to camp.
- Mask will be required in common areas and provided by camper.

- Each camp will have access to onsite Covid19 nasal test (administered by a trained camp representative).

2021 KJT Summer Youth & Teen Camps Covid-19 Protocol Flow Chart

If Camper has **ONE** of the following signs or symptoms:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle Pain
- Headache
- Sore Throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Known close contact with a person who is nasal test confirmed to have Covid-19 if exposure to the test-confirmed case occurred within the last 14 days.

Camper is Quarantined and sent to Camp Nurse.

Camper's is given C19 nasal test and parent/legal guardian is called.

Possible C19 Camper nasal test result is Negative.

Possible C19 Camper nasal test result is Positive.

Camper can return to camp after 24hrs if no signs or symptoms.

Camper is not allowed back to camp, Parent/Legal Guardian is called to pick up Camper. Suggested to obtain a 2nd C19 PRC test and contact Primary Care Physician for guidance.

Possible C19 Camper's group & assigned Counselors are quarantined in their cabin until C19 nasal test result is received.

Possible C19 Camper nasal test Result is Negative.

Possible C19 Camper nasal test result is Positive.

Group may return to regular camp activities.

Camper's group Parent/Legal Guardians are contacted and group is sent home.

Campers/Counselors in group are not allowed back into camp. Suggested to contact Primary Care Physician for guidance & quarantine for appropriate time.

- Camper who receives a Positive Nasal Test is recommended to obtain a 2nd C19 Test (Polymerase Chain Reaction – "PRC" Test) to confirm results.
- Any Camper who leaves camp due to C19 Protocols are recommended to contact their Primary Care Physician to seek guidance.
