Bishop David Kagan has approved the US Catholic Conference of Bishop's (USCCB) special, emergency Hurricane Irma collection for the weekend of October 7 & 8 in all parishes of the Diocese of Bismarck. The funds collected for this one-time special, emergency collection for Hurricane Irma Relief will be used for immediate emergency needs for necessities such as water, food, shelter, and medical care as well as to the long term needs to rebuild and recover after widespread destruction, and of the USCCB for pastoral and reconstruction aid to the Church in the United States and in the Caribbean.
