Hurricane Harvey Collection
September 9th & 10th, 2017

Bishop David Kagan has approved the United States Catholic Conference of Bishop's (USCCB) special, emergency Hurricane Harvey collection for the weekend of September 9 & 10 in all parishes of the Diocese of Bismarck. The funds collected for this one-time special, emergency collection for Hurricane Harvey Relief will be used to support the efforts of Catholic Charities USA, the official domestic relief agency of the U.S. Catholic Church, as they and their member agencies respond to immediate emergency needs for necessities such as water, food, shelter, and medical care as well as to the long term needs to rebuild and recover after widespread destruction, and of the USCCB for pastoral and reconstruction aid to the Church. There will be a special collection taken up at the masses next weekend.
