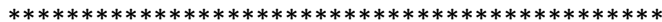

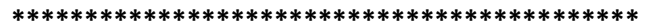

Note on Ash Wednesday Distribution of Ashes in a Time of Pandemic

The Priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general: 'Repent, and believe in the Gospel', or 'Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return'.

The Priest then cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask and distributes the ashes to those who come to him or, if appropriate, he goes to those who are standing in their places. The Priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything.

Fasting and abstinence during Lent

During the season of Lent, Catholics are called to take part in certain days of fasting and abstinence, **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are the **two days of both fasting and abstinence**. In addition, **all Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence.***

Fasting: The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal.

Abstinence: The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

*Exceptions to these guidelines include those who are physically or mentally ill as well as pregnant and nursing mothers.

Check the mass schedule, read the Sunday bulletin, get Religious Ed information, Formed, access Finance Council minutes, and much more.

New changes for Mass:

1. Spacing in church is eliminated.
2. Funeral Vigils and Visitations before Mass may be in the Church at the Pastor’s discretion.
3. Extra-Ordinary Ministers of the Eucharist at the Pastor’s discretion may resume for Parish Masses only.
4. Mass Servers at the discretion of the pastor and with the permission of parents may resume.
5. Choirs for Parish Masses may resume participation with the usual numbers.
6. Holy water may be put into the fonts in the church.
7. Penance Services are allowed but only with the use of screens.

No Change:

1. Holy Communion under the one species of the Consecrated Host.
2. The Sign of Peace remains suspended.
3. No offertory procession with the gifts.
4. No face-to-face Confessions.

The Knights of Columbus will be having the Fish Fries on three Fridays in Lent. They will be on February 26, and March 12 and 26. They will serve from 6:00 – 7:00pm following Stations of the Cross at 5:30pm. They will offer meals to go for anyone wanting their meal that way.
