Hello parents and guardians,

It's already time to apply for financial aid for the 2016-2017 school year. Financial aid includes both parish and Diocesan support and scholarships. In other words, if you are looking for any type of tuition reduction, you will need to complete and submit the PSAS form. **It must be postmarked or submitted online by November 19, 2015.** There are two ways to submit the form this year:

1. [PSAS Online Application](#) You can enter your information directly through the online application for faster processing of your account.
2. [PSAS Interactive PDF](#) You can complete this online, print it and mail it in - or print it, complete it by hand and mail it in. ***Important: You must download the PDF and save it to your computer before filling it out. To properly complete the form, you must open it within Adobe Reader or Adobe Acrobat. Do not "view" the PDF and attempt to complete it in your browser. This will result in an unusable PDF and/or improperly recorded information.*** (Form instructions are in the document after the form.) Using the PDF will delay the processing of your financial aid, as the information will need to be entered once it arrives at PSAS.

The ASA School Code (0551) is pre-printed on the PSAS form.
