Dear ASA Families,

As we prepare for the 2020-2021 school year (however that may look) we wanted to make sure we stay caught up on registration and planning for next fall. We know that uncertainties still abound, and the stress of this global health crisis still lingers. We cannot, however, serve our families the best way possible without knowing who will be here next year.

Because of current limitations due to COVID-19 we will be moving our enrollment process to an online form. What does this mean?

- If you already completed a paper registration and nothing has changed for your family, nothing else is needed at this time. If you can't remember if you turned in your paperwork, [simply complete the short online form](#).
- If you have yet to complete registration, [please use the online form](#). If you are hopeful to return, but just don't know for certain, please complete the online form and email Mr. Deбри with any additional information you would like to share.
- If you know you are NOT returning to All Saints Academy next year, [please fill out the form](#) by selecting "We will not be returning to All Saints Academy for the 2020-2021 school year."

### **Parish Investment Form**

Families who are active parishioners in good standing at one of our four founding parishes are eligible for tuition discounts. Families must be registered in a parish, contributing regularly, and actively participating in liturgy and parish life to be considered "active."

Only students enrolled in grades K-8 are eligible for multiple child discounts. Early Childhood programs and child care fees are separate, and not eligible for multiple child parish investment.

After completing [the Parish Investment form](#), your information will be sent to your parish in May for approval by the pastor or his designee. You will be informed by All Saints Academy if your pastor has NOT signed off on your parish investment request.

### **Financial Aid**

To apply for financial aid for your ASA student, you must complete a Smart Aid online application ([SmartAid Online Form Instructions](#), [Smart Aid Online Application](#)).

You are encouraged to [complete the form online](#). If you do not have access to a computer, please contact the All Saints Academy Business Manager, Darrell Beckwith at (616) 447-2997, ext. 1251 for assistance. We can make available both a computer and an advocate for you.

The Bishop Scholarships are awarded on a first come-first served basis, so the sooner you apply the better. ASA only considers assistance requests after parish assistance has been requested. **All families who receive financial assistance MUST complete the SMART AID application.**
