Through the generosity of many, we are happy to share that we have raised nearly \$30,000. This is an incredible amount! We have had gifts both large and small, ranging from \$5 to over \$5,000. Every single dollar helps.

Also, with the help of different subsidies, our original amount can be readjusted. This is also great news! All Saints Academy is already in a better financial situation than we had projected.

However, we know that we are still losing preschool and child care income each week. And we also know that families continue to be affected by the economic impact of COVID-19.
