The Parish of St. Theresa is very pleased to announce that the Food Pantry will reopen on *Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup>* at 2pm. The Food Pantry has been closed since *April 1<sup>st</sup>* due to the growing concern about the spread of the coronavirus. In the meantime, we have been assisting people through the parish office in cases of emergency. However, due to an awareness of the continual needs of the community, we have decided to officially reopen the Parish Food Pantry. After the initial reopening on *Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup>*, the Food Pantry will remain open on *Mondays, Wednesdays, & Fridays from 2pm to 4pm.*

In order ensure the safety of all involved, the following steps will be taken:

- All food bags will be packaged by volunteers
- All food bags will be picked up in a drive-by fashion
- Volunteers will:
  - Be limited to 4 per day
  - Be under 65 and relatively in good health
  - Wear masks and gloves and use other appropriate sanitary precautions
  - Will not have any direct contact with recipients

If anyone wants to donate at this time, we are most in need of cereal, juice, pancake mix, syrup, pasta, sauce, and toilet paper. These items, as well as any other nonperishable items, can be dropped off directly at the Pantry during the hours of operation listed above. (*641 Radio Road*)

On behalf of the parish, I would like to express our gratitude to Mayor Bobbi Jo Crea and Little Egg Harbor Township for assisting us at this time, as well as the members of the Food Pantry Board for their commitment to serving the needs of our community through the Parish Food Pantry.
