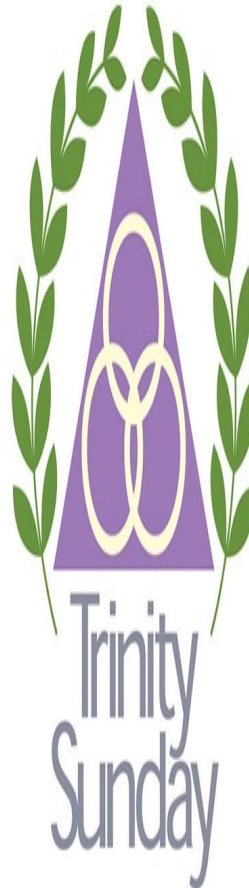

Knights of Columbus Council 2616

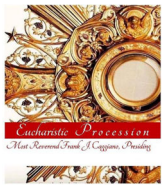
The Knights of Columbus on Unquowa Road have sold their building and have moved into our chapel in the Church.
