Students in the eighth grade Religious Education Home School program will read and complete the Sadlier text: Inspired by the Spirit of Confirmation, Candidate Book.

Once the book is read and the questions are answered, students will return to the Religious Education office, the *entire completed book, with answers marked in the book*, by **January 14, 2021**.

Below are suggested chapter completion dates:

Read chapters 1 and 2. Answer questions found on pages:

7,9,11,12,13,14,15,17,19,21,22,23,25,27 and 29.

Write the answers in the book. Chapters 1 and 2 should be completed by the end of October.

Read chapters 3 and 4. Answer questions found on pages: 31,33,34,35,37,39,41,43,45,46,47,49,51 and 53.

Write the answers in the book. Chapters 3 and 4 should be completed by the end of November.

Read chapters 5. Answer questions found on pages:

55,57,59,61,63,65.

Write the answers in the book. Chapters 5 should be completed by January 14, 2021.

Saint Report: Choosing a Confirmation name is an important part of preparing for the sacrament of Confirmation. Students should think carefully about which name to choose by considering which saint's life story holds some personal meaning for you. Think about the virtues the saint exhibited, and which saint's life you would like to emulate. You may select a name based on a saint's patronage. Based on the circumstances of their lives, saints become "patrons" of certain people, places, things, occupations, etc. There is a patron for virtually every cause, profession or special interest. Or, if you like, you may take your Confirmation name from a parent, grandparent, or sponsor. This is perfectly acceptable so long as the parent, grandparent or sponsor is named after a Catholic saint. Lastly, it is also perfectly acceptable *not* to choose a new name. If you were given a Christian name at Baptism, some Confirmation candidates choose to reinforce the link between Baptism and Confirmation by using their baptismal name for Confirmation. If you decide to use your baptismal name, then your saint report should be on your given baptismal name. Each Confirmation candidate, *whether selecting a new name or using his or her baptismal name, must hand in a saint report*.

The saint report should be at least two typed pages (250 words) double-spaced.

The saint report should include a brief biography of the saint, the saint's admirable qualities, and how you would like to emulate this saint.

Include a cover page with your report with your saint's name, your name, and date.

Saint reports are due December 3, 2020.



Other Requirements for eighth grade Confirmation Candidates:

- Sponsor Certificate (yellow form): Due November 25, 2020
 - Roll Book Form (orange form): Due November 25, 2020
 - Service Hours: Requirement waived.
 - Confirmation Retreat: Pending. Information to follow.
 - Letter to Pastor: Replaced by interview with Pastor. Details to follow.
 - Confirmation Test: Replaced by interview with Pastor. Details to follow.
 - Supplemental on-line assignments: As assigned.
 - Confirmation Penance Service: Date to be announced.
- * SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION: Date to be announced.**

*Saint Thomas Aquinas students *usually* receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in February or March. If the date of Confirmation is postponed, *completed* assignments and fulfilled requirements will *not* have to be repeated.
