

### **Cincture**

Fabric cord used to wrap around the waist over the alb to keep secure. In liturgical colors of white, green, purple, and red to match liturgical seasons.

### **Communion Cups**

Stemmed vessel with a cup-like top, usually small than the chalice used by the priest. It is used to help distribute the Precious Blood during communion.

### **Cope**

Long, cape-like garment worn over alb used during Benediction or in processions.

### **Corporal**

Square cloth folded into nine smaller squares, used at the altar on which the Chalice and Paten are placed during the Mass.

### **Cruets**

Small pitchers, usually with a stopper, holding water and wine.

### **Dalmatic**

Loose-fitting garment worn over the alb by deacons, sometimes similar to the chasuble of the priest in liturgical colors.

### **Deacon Stole**

Long cloth scarf in liturgical colors worn by deacon over one shoulder.

### **Flagon**

Large vessels used to hold the wine.

### **Funeral Pall**

A large cloth that is used to cover a funeral casket

### **Host**

The special unleavened bread used at Mass
