

### **Priest Stole**

Long cloth scarf in liturgical colors worn by priest over both shoulders

### **Purificator**

Small white cloths used to wipe clean the Chalice holding the Precious Blood.

### **Lavabo**

Small dish used to catch the water when the priest washes his hands during the offertory.

### **Lectionary**

Large book containing the Scriptural readings from the Old and New Testament for Mass. (Also include the Gospels)

### **Monstrance**

Large, ornate vessel used to hold the Blessed Sacrament for Benediction, Eucharistic processions, and Eucharistic adoration.

### **Pall**

Small, cloth-covered cardboard square placed on top of the priest's chalice to protect the Precious Blood.

### **Paten**

Saucer-like dish, frequently matching the chalice, used to hold the Body of Christ

### **Processional Cross**

Crucifix mounted on a long pole used to lead procession.

### **Sacramentary**

Large book containing all the prayers (except the Scripture readings) the priest uses at Mass.

### **Sanctuary Lamp**

A candle normally surrounded by red glass that when lit lets people know that Jesus is present in the tabernacle.
