Trinity Sunday

The Feast of the Most Holy Trinity was first instituted in the tenth century by Bishop Stephen of Liege and spread quickly throughout the Low Countries, Germany, and England and then later to France, Spain, and Italy. The papacy long resisted its adoption in Rome, partly because of a conservative reluctance to approve a purely theological feast with no basis in a particular event of salvation history and also because every Eucharist was truly a festival of the Trinity. But in 1334 Pope John XXII commanded the feast to be celebrated throughout the Latin Church. Two centuries earlier, St. Thomas Becket popularized Trinity Sunday in England and directed that its observance be kept with special dignity.

Originally a votive Mass of the Trinity, the liturgical commemoration of the Triune God came to be celebrated on the Octave Day of Pentecost in the Western Church. Among Eastern Christians, this same Sunday commemorates the Communion of Saints. Western Christendom fixed upon the doctrine of the Trinity to conclude the first half of the liturgical year as a fitting culmination of the sequence of observances of God's revelation of Himself and His redemptive purposes in time.

Today's festival is a mysterious synthesis of Christmas, Epiphany, Easter, Ascension, and Pentecost: God came to dwell among us in the Incarnation of His Son; He was made manifest to the Gentiles; Christ fasted and prayed with us through Lent, until He worked the Paschal Mystery of our salvation, ascending then to the Father and giving to His Church the indwelling Paraclete. Through the Son, we know the Father and come to receive the Spirit. Our liturgical enactment of the life of Jesus issues, then, in the celebration of the ultimate revelation of what the Godhead truly is from all eternity, Three Persons in One God.

It is appropriate that Solemn Mass on Trinity Sunday in this parish begins, according to custom, with that great articulation of the Trinitarian mystery, the Athanasian Creed, sung in procession. Of the Athanasian Creed, Blessed John Henry Newman famously wrote, "It is a psalm or hymn of praise, of confession, and of profound, self-prostrating homage, parallel to the canticles of the elect in heaven. It appeals to the imagination quite as much as to the intellect. It is the great war-song of our faith."
