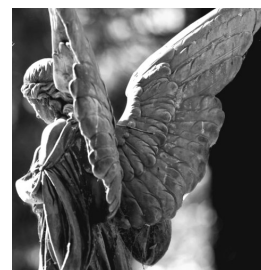

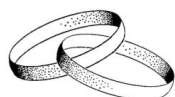
### The Greatest of Gifts: Holy Sacrifice of the Mass
