Please read below for more detailed guidance:

### Obligation Remains Commuted

First and foremost, **the obligation to attend Mass in the Ordinariate is still commuted** and will be for the foreseeable future. Meaning, the faithful **do not** have to attend public Mass and can continue as they have for the past weeks. **This is very important for those who are at risk** because of age, or who have underlying health risks, or who do not feel comfortable being in public. If you are part of any of these categories, you are encouraged to stay at home.

With this in mind, the Cathedral will continue to live-stream the 11:15 a.m. Solemn Mass for the foreseeable future. Please access the live-stream on our website: [olwcatholic.org](http://olwcatholic.org)

The **4:30 Anticipated Mass (Vigil)** will continue in the **same manner** as previous weeks, except that there will be Organ music played, without congregational singing. It remains a 65 and older Mass and households will be sat every other pew.

At all Masses staff and volunteers of the Cathedral will be greeting parishioners at the Porte-cochere and helping to direct them to their seats.

Some further notes on social distancing:

- We are asking parishioners to sit with their household. We request households to sit appropriately socially distanced from each other in the Cathedral.
- It has been recommended that all attendees sanitize their hands and put on masks before entering the Church. For this purpose we have placed hand sanitizer at each entrance.
- Collection plates will not be passed during Mass. A collection plate will be placed near the entrance and exit for your continued donations to the Church. You may also utilize the online giving option on our website.
