

Marian Pilgrimage “Trip Expectations”

Please remember that this is a Pilgrimage, not a vacation. The Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help (<http://shrineofourladyofgoodhelp.com>) is the only *Church Approved* Marian Apparition sight in the United States! We will also be visiting the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe (www.guadalupe Shrine.org). There are special graces and indulgences one can receive from this pilgrimage; we will talk about those on the pilgrimage.

At each one of the shrines, we will have Mass. Teens will also have time for quiet prayer and reflection either in the Church, or outside walking on the beautiful grounds at each shrine. There will also be time for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Please remember to pack accordingly. We will be walking outside at the shrines, **so a warm coat is a must**. There is a nice pool, game room, and social area at the hotel, so you can bring your swimsuits, but modesty is a requirement – no exceptions! We will travel by a deluxe motor coach bus. Teens will be responsible for two meals while enroute, as well as any snacks purchased at our stops. Each shrine also has a gift shop.

If you have a Bible and Rosary, please bring them. Other Spiritual Reading books are also recommended. We will have time on the bus for you to bring other books to read, or to work on homework. Do not bring along any inappropriate books, music, DVDs, magazines, etc. We are staying at the Best Western Green Bay Inn (920-499-3161) in Green Bay, WI There will be four people to a room, so everyone will have a bed to sleep on.

Please note that this pilgrimage is open to all 8th grade and high school teens who desire to spend extended periods of quiet time in prayer and reflection. Our registration deadline is October 12th, but once the bus is full – it’s full. Please register early to reserve your seat. Because of a generous benefactor, this pilgrimage is only \$40, with scholarships available.

8am – Depart for Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help

8:45am – Arrive at Shrine – 30 minutes of Prayer and Reflection

9:15am – Father Gallas’s talk

10am – Private time for Prayer and Devotions – Confessions available

11am – Mass

12:30pm – Lunch (Provided)

1:00pm – Holy Hour at the Shrine, time for Prayer and Confession

2:15pm – Depart Shrine to return home (Dinner stop enroute)

8:15pm – Arrive at St Anne

8:30pm – Arrive at Ss. Peter and Paul
