

WEDNESDAY NIGHT BINGO!

A quick reference sheet

BINGO is one of the biggest things that keeps our school ALIVE.
Can you help us make it even *better*?

St. Elizabeth Bingo is every Wednesday night at the KC Hall.

- The last 2 years, BINGO profit totaled \$359,565, for an average of \$179,782/year!
- Profits forwarded from Wednesday BINGO to the Parish/School for those 2 years totaled \$282,000 for an average of \$141,000/year.
- In September, 2015, BINGO forwarded an additional \$30,000 on top of their normal contribution to pay for the new Hobart dishwasher in the Cafeteria. Other recent BINGO profits have also assisted with paying for the new wheelchair lift for the gymnasium, technology for the classrooms, microscopes for the science lab, ***and this year....***

On September 12th we hope all our school families will come PLAY BINGO as this night will directly support the funding of all of the new after-school Club endeavors at St. E's this year.

Bring a friend and get the word out! And there are other games:

Besides bingo, there is: pull tabs, speed ball, lucky pot, race horse, and 50/50. Anyone 18 and older can attend and play, just show up!

If you opt-in to work BINGO, it saves you **\$700** off your child's tuition, it saves you even more if you have more than one student! You can sign up to be a BINGO worker when you register for school. Kathy Lickenbrock then assigns you to a team (each week of the month has a team) and you receive a particular job. We hope to get more families involved each year.

The total family commitment is 13 BINGO nights per year. (1 week per month and an additional "5th Wednesday" once a year) Team 1 works the first Wednesday of the month, Team 2 works the 2nd Wednesday of the month and so on.. If there are 5 Wednesdays in the month, the teams rotate these. There are two shifts: 5:15 to 7:30 pm and 6:30 until finished.

The BINGO "year" runs from the 1st week of June, prior to the start of the current school year, and runs through May, the completion of the school year. Families who opt-in to working BINGO are required to work their scheduled night or find a replacement worker. Failure to work or find a substitute will result in a \$100 inconvenience fee for No-show/No-sub.

- + All BINGO workers are required to attend one mandatory training meeting each year with Kathy.
- + (All families requesting and receiving tuition assistance are required to work BINGO)
