#### **LENT**

The Holy Season of Lent begins Ash Wednesday, February 18<sup>th</sup>. On Ash Wednesday, Masses here at Sacred Heart will be at 11:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Masses at Holy Angels will be a 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. During Lent there will be Mass every Wednesday at Sacred Heart at 6:30 p.m. with confessions and Eucharistic Adoration from 5 – 6:15 p.m. Stations of the Cross will be held on all Fridays during Lent at 7 p.m.

#### **LENTEN REGULATIONS**

All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. All Catholics who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are bound to observe days of abstinence on which NO meat may be eaten. In addition, Ash Wednesday, February 18<sup>th</sup> and Good Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> are days of fast and abstinence. Besides no meat, we may eat only one full meal on these days. All Catholics who have reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and are less than 60 years of age are bound to observe the fast. To deliberately break these regulations is a serious sin.
